When Omar is done, he brings the cart back to the barn. Then he sits on his deck and looks at his garden with pride.








Marvel at the Shore








Trip to the Market










Once they had all their items, they gave the saleswoman their cash. Then, they departed the market. They got back in their car and drove home for a yummy lunch.








My Sister's Fern








A Turtle can Surf!










Irma would surf until sunset. When the sun was no longer in the sky, she would skip back home. Once she was home, she would curl up in her turtle bed and relax.








The Worst Pet Ever










Fishing at the Port









Travis and his father wanted to go fishing at the port. They drove to the tackle store to pick up some items. They had to get some fishing line and a jar of worms.
